

English

In English, we will be using the book The Way Home for Wolf to guide the children to produce their own narrative and non – fiction information text. Within each lesson, there will be a focus on spelling, punctuation or grammar.

Maths

We begin the term by focusing on number and place value up to 100, ensuring children have a good understanding of the importance of place value. We then move onto developing the children's understanding of addition and subtraction in various concrete, pictorial and abstract ways. Following this unit, we move on to learning about measurement, involving money. We finish the term with a focus of multiplication and division, again embedding concrete, pictorial and abstract methods.

Computing

This term, we will be focusing our online identity in Online Safety - looking at how people may look and act differently online than offline. We will also be learning about what a computer is.

Foundation Subjects

In Geography, we will be researching geographical similarities and differences of our local area and contrasting it to Mugurameno Village, Zambia. In History, we will be focusing on Remembrance day and how we remember soldiers from our local area. In Art, we will be focusing on the skill of drawing with a focus on patterns. The children will learn how to produce an African-inspired mask, decorated with patterns and colours. In DT we will be creating a puppet, using a chosen template and joining technique.

Science

We begin the term learning about changing shape. We will be finding out how the shapes of solid objects can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. We will then move on to the uses of materials and will be identifying and comparing the suitability of everyday materials.

PE

This term, PE is going to be taught by Mr Sharp. The lessons will take place on a Thursday morning. The focus is on fundamental skills of throwing and catching and defending and attacking.
