

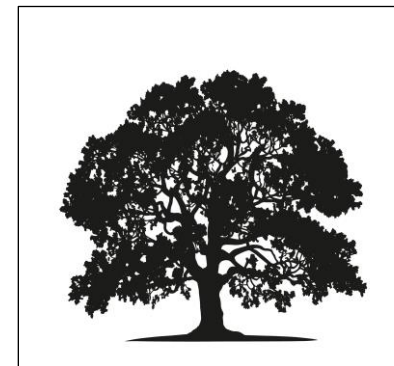
English
