

### **English**

We begin the term with instruction writing. The children will be making their own chocolate cake and then writing their own set of instructions. We then move onto a narrative text 'Handa's Surprise'.

### **PSHE**

We begin the term with the unit Being My Best, where we will be discussing the importance of healthy eating, exercise and sleep. In Summer 2, we move onto the unit 'Growing and Changing' where we will be exploring life stages e.g. of plants, animals and humans.

### **Expressive Arts and Design**

In Art, we begin the term with observational drawing. In DT, the children will develop and practise threading and weaving techniques using various materials. In Music, the children will learn that music and instruments can be used to convey moods, they will also learn about the four different groups of musical instruments, before following a beat using an untuned instrument.

### **Forest school**

Forest School will continue to take place on a Wednesday afternoon and is led by Mrs Shaw. Please ensure that your child is provided with weather appropriate clothing and footwear. Thank you.

### **Maths**

We begin the term focusing on counting forwards and backwards from a given number in order to add and subtract. The children will also be counting to 20 and back to 0, identifying one more and one less, and comparing and representing numbers. They will also be introduced to the mathematical patterns of doubling, halving and odd and even numbers.

### **Understanding the World**

In Science, we begin the term investigating floating and sinking and waterproof materials. In History, the children will be learning about migration linked the story 'Welcome' by Barroux. In Geography, the children will be looking at environments different to where they live, further developing their map skills. In RE, the focus is on what is special about our world and the places that are special for different people and why.

### **PE**

PE will continue to take place on a Wednesday and Thursday morning. This term, the focus is on performing a variety of rolls, balances, and travels showing increasing control. Please ensure earrings are removed on these days.
