

English

In English, the first focus is a non-fiction text where the children write a travel journal from various habitats. This will lead to a poetry unit about the Song of the Sea and then an adventure story based on an island. Within each lesson, there will be a focus on spelling, punctuation or grammar.

Computing

This term, the focus will be about keeping safe when using technology and the use of passwords. We will also be learning about programable toys and digital imagery.

PSHE

We will be considering our school values Respect and Ambition. We will learn about how we can strive to be our best, how we grow/change, and how to keep safe when out and about (road safety).

Science

We will be learning about the classification of animals (including humans), considering body parts and senses. We will also be learning about plants, identifying common wild and garden plants, as well as describing the basic structure and requirements for growth.

Maths

This term we will be learning about multiplication, division and fractions (halves and quarters). We will continue to develop our knowledge about numbers to 100 and place value. We will also learn about size, weight, volume and time.
