Reports and Assessments

All of the Class Teachers have been busy writing reports in recent weeks about the progress your child has made this academic year. Each class's reports are due to be sent out on Friday 10th July. For the children in Reception, Year 1, Year 4 and Year 6, there will be additional academic results included as those year groups take part in the statutory testing/teacher assessments that must be reported to the Department of Education as set out below:

- For Reception aged children, parents/carers will be notified of whether their child has achieved each of the Early Learning Goals.
- In Year 1, all children took part in the Phonics Screening Check to assess their early reading (If a child didn't achieve the pass mark in Year 1, they have resat the check this year in Year 2).
- The children in Year 4 completed the Multiplication Check.
- Year 6 took part in the End of Key Stage 2 SATs in May which assessed the children on Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling, Reading and Maths. There will also be a Teacher Assessment for Writing based on several pieces of writing the children have produced this year. This year's Year 6 SATs results will be released on Tuesday 7th July.

As usual, a letter will be included explaining the layout of the reports as well as the data that is included.
